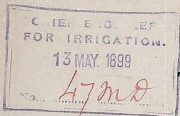

In allusion to your letter No. 82 of  
25 April 1899, I beg to submit a memo-  
randum of my charges for the negatives  
supplied to the Government -

For producing 3 negatives  
12" x 10" size. Paper. 55-0-0

For travelling twice to a dis-  
tance of about 18 miles including  
the special charge for out. door  
photography . . . . . 11-0-0

Total Rs 65-0-0

I beg to add that my special charge  
for producing the 3 negatives was Rs 80/-  
But on the request of Mr. T. W. S. Sanyal  
Executive Engineer, I reduced my charge  
to Rs 65-0-0. Even this amount of my  
bill of 4. 9. 99 has not been paid me yet.  
I beg to request therefore that you will  
be kind enough to add the interest  
at one per cent to the amount of  
Rs 65/- being the total of my bill
