Transferred To Vellore Jail

Vellore, July 27.

Swami Arunagirinathar, "Dictator", Anti-Hindi movement, who was sentenced to undergo rigorous imprisonment for one year, by the Third Presidency Magistrate, Egmore, and who was serving the sentence in the Madras Penitentiary was brought here under Police escort along with criminals at 6 p.m.

From the railway station, he was taken to the Sub-jail where he spent the night. On the following morning, he was taken along with notorious criminals to the Central Jail.

The news of his being taken to the Central Jail spread like wild fire in the town and a large number of people went there to have a darshan of Swamiji.

Interviewed by Mr. Annal Thango, the Swamiji said that the Anti-Hindi volunteers who have been sentenced and who are serving their sentences in the Penitentiary were all very cheerful. There was a decrease, Swamiji said, in his weight by 9 lbs. He also said that there was every likelihood of the Anti-Hindi volunteers, convicted, to be transferred to the Vellore Jail.
