

Public Meeting To Condemn  
Hindi

Salem, July 1.

At a public meeting held last night under the auspices of the Salem Ammapet S.I.L.F. at the Mariammen Koil Maidan, Mr. A. Ganesha San-karan B. A., B. L., presiding, Conjeevaram Paravasthu Sri C. Rajagopala Achariar spoke on "Present day Political Situation and Compulsory Hindi."

In the course of his speech, Mr. Achariar dwelt at length on the great value and usefulness of the Tamil Literature and explained in detail the unfounded arguments put forth by the Madras Premier in support of Hindi. He pointed out that the introduction of compulsory Hindi in this province was only the first step to bring the Tamilians under the foot of the North-Indians. The speaker finally exhorted all Tamilians to protest against the action of the Congress Premier and see that his Government was either mended or ended.
