

PARENTS ASKED NOT TO SEND CHILDREN TO HINDI SCHOOLS

Resolution of Anti-Hindi Meeting

Coimbatore, July 5.

Under the auspices of the Coimbatore Anti-Hindi League, a public meeting was held in the Victoria Town Hall Maidan, on the 4th inst. at 5.30 p. m., under the presidentship of Mr. Muthu Naidu, Municipal Councillor, when speeches were made by Messrs. C. Muhammed Yusuf Sahib, Muhammed Muthu Sahib, P. V. Hanumantha Rao of Madura and Srimathi Thulasi Bai Ammal of Vellore, protesting against the introduction of compulsory Hindustani, condemning the action of the Madras government for the "repressive measures" adopted by them to put down the Anti-Hindi movement, appealing to the parents not to send their children to schools wherein Hindi was taught and calling on the people to continue the agitation till the Congress ministry dropped the proposal.

The meeting terminated at 10 p. m.
