

PROTEST AGAINST REPRESSIVE POLICY

Anti-Hindi Day at Coimbatore

Coimbatore, July 3.

The "Anti-Hindi Day" was observed in Coimbatore under the auspices of the Anti-Hindi League, on the 1st of July 1938, the Madras Government's repressive measures" adopted to put down the agitation and passed through the main streets of the town, and terminated at the Victoria Town Hall maidan, where a largely atten-

ded public meeting was held under the presidentship of Mr. Muthu Naidu, Municipal Councillor. Messrs. P. V. Hanumantha Rao of Madura and Janab Muhammed Muthu Sahib were the principal speakers.

Resolutions were passed opposing the introduction of compulsory Hindi, protesting against the Madras Government's repressive measures" adopted to put down the agitation and calling on the people to support the Anti-Hindi Campaign. Resolutions were communicated to the authorities concerned.
