

ANTI-HINDI AGITATION

Volunteers Sentenced To 4 Months R. I.

Madras, Aug. 20.

On a charge of picketing in front of the Hindu Theological High School in connection with the Anti-Hindi movement, the following persons were arrested by the police and produced before Mr. L. R. Venkatarama Iyer, Second Presidency Magistrate who sentenced them to four months rigorous imprisonment each.

Two volunteers, Sundaraja Nadar and Arumuga Pillai were sentenced by the Fourth Presidency Magistrate for picketing in front of the Hindu Theological High School to four months R. I. each.
