

CASE AGAINST SWAMI ARUNAGIRINATHAR

Madras, July 2.

Swami Arunagirinathar, "Dictator" of the Anti-Hindi Movement who was arrested by the Police during the last week was produced before Mr. B. Madhava Rao, Third Presidency Magistrate, Egmore on Wednesday last.

He was charged under Sec. 117, I. P. C., in that he made three speeches at various places in Madras on three different occasions. It was alleged that he incited people in those speeches to stage a satyagraha opposite the Premier's house in Bazlullah Road, Theagaroyanagar, with a view to compelling the Premier to have the Government Order relating to the introduction of Hindi in schools, cancelled.

The accused admitted having made the speeches, but in a statement, denied having said anything which amounted to incitement to satyagraha.
